

INVITES:

Professional Appraisers, Educators, Investigators and all members of FECOVAL affiliated schools, Mexican Institutes of Valuation, Societies of Appraisers of México, Foreign Appraisal Associations, Related Organizations and Institutions of Higher Education.

TO PARTICIPATE AS SPEAKERS:

At the LVI National Valuation Congress, XI International Congress the WAVO, to be held from October 14 to October 17 of the present year at the Fiesta Americana Hotel in the City of Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico.

REQUIREMENTS:

I.- OBJECTIVES

- To offer an opportunity for Professional Appraisers Members of all FECOVAL affiliated schools, Mexican Institutes of Valuation, Societies of Appraisers, Foreign Appraisal Associations, Related Organizations and Institutions of Higher Education, to share experiences and investigation results on current appraisal issues.
- To promote investigation in the field of Appraising.
- To propose specific solutions, applying the applicable methodology or criteria to be considered as an advancement to be used by the professional appraisers; or serious investigations on valuation issues that have been made, which have obtained relevant results to be used by the Professional Appraiser.
- To submit and discuss among the participants proposals and works related to the issues found around the different Appraisal fields.
- To promote and share appraising practices that will contribute to the construction of a more just and equal society.



II.- TOPICS AND PROGRAM:

The Congress' Main theme is:

“THE VALUE OF EVOLUTION”

Interested parties must submit research papers related to one or more of the following areas of knowledge.

The suggested lines of investigation are the following:

- Real Estate Appraising.
- Machinery and Equipment Appraising.
- Industrial Appraising.
- Agricultural Appraising.
- Company Appraising.
- Appraising Intangibles.
- Appraising Works of Art.
- Jewel Appraising and other Appraising Specialties.

III.- BASIS FOR PARTICIPATION

1.- Professional Appraisers, Educators, Investigators and all members of FECOVAL affiliated schools, Mexican Institutes of Valuation, Societies of Appraisers of México, Foreign Appraisal Associations, Related Organizations and Institutions of Higher Education.

2.- The presentation should preferably be unpublished, and never previously presented at any other Congress, with the author being solely responsible for any damage to third parties regarding any copyright infringement that could be claimed in the future.

Previously published or presented material will be allowed, as long as the author makes the pertinent and timely clarification and that the topic of the work is considered relevant by the Commission of Technical and/or Scientific Affairs, designated by the Congress' Organizing Committee and the FECOVAL Technical Council. These works may be shown, but they will not have the right to be considered at the awards ceremony.

There may be works or presentations that contribute new or updated knowledge to the field of valuation in relationship to the current conditions being experienced worldwide, more specifically in our region and in Mexico.

Regardless of the ideas expressed in its presentation, the speakers must adjust to deliver the material to the extent they deem appropriate and send it in accordance with the provisions in Chapter V of this regulation in order that such work may be included in Congress' Memoirs.



3.- Proposals must be based upon work completed within the last three years. It may be submitted individually or in co-authorship of no more than three co-authors per paper.

4.- The works will be reviewed by specialists of the field (Arbitration Body), by means of a "blind" review method, that is, they will not know the author's name. The Arbitration Body will accept or not the works to be presented in the Congress, and this opinion is indisputable.

IV.- FORMAT

- The paper must be sent electronically in a Word Document Format. The length is limited to a maximum of 25 pages and a minimum of 15, including cover and references. The document should be summarized in a maximum of two pages (the appendix will be considered additional material, but should not exceed five pages).
- The cover page should include: the Congress' name, its motto, title of work in quotation marks, name of the author, association to which he/she belongs to and/or institution he/she represents, and the date.
- The paper must include an index with titles, subtitles, and page number of each one.
- Each paper should start with a brief introduction by the speaker, making a semblance of his/her curriculum with a brief description of their professional, guild and academic activities, limited to one page in length.
- All drawings, formulas, photographs and tables should be interspersed in the text of the work in letter-sized sheets and be completely clear, legible and of high resolution.
- Subtitles should be written in capital letters and without underlining. The wording should be written in the third person singular, in a clear, objective manner and in Spanish or English.
- The format of the document should be 1.5 interspacing and double space between paragraphs, Arial font size 12. All papers submitted must include a SUMMARY of a maximum of 2 pages, including 5 keywords and conclusions on one page.
- Complete information such as the title of the works, date, edition, author's complete name, references used, etc. is mandatory.
- The front cover of all works will be removed when given to the Reviewers for their assessment. Therefore, names of the authors or the Institutions they represent should not be visible in any other part of the presentation, avoiding Reviewers from inferring the origin of the work. Likewise, due to the blind arbitration procedure which takes place, we request NOT to send the works in PDF file format, for the purpose of alphanumeric classification. If this was the case, the work will not be processed.



- Once the committee receives the full work to be assessed, no name changes of the author or co-authors will be accepted, nor will the inclusions of other co-authors. All documents should be completely reviewed before submitting.
- The second page of the paper should contain a summary of it, with a maximum length of two pages. The summaries should provide sufficient information about the presentation, objectives, methodology and results.
- All papers must at least include objectives, methodology, data analysis, results, recommendations or improvement proposal and references.
- With the exception of the cover, all pages must be numbered.
- Once the paper is accepted, it will be mandatory for the author or at least one of the co-authors (if there are several), to participate in the meeting and present the work personally, in accordance with the specified times and schedules.

V.- WORKS SUBMITTING

- Deadline for submission is Tuesday, **June 30, 2020 at 23:59** hours Central Standard Time in Mexico.
- The works must only be sent electronically to the following e-mail:

The author or authors of the work must accompany it with the following:

- Curriculum vitae (Resume) of his/her professional career, summarized in one page.
- Digital photograph of the author(s) showing upper body, wearing formal attire.
- Letter from the Association or School of Appraisers to which he/she belongs to as proof of Membership (if applicable).
- Letter from the Educational Institution or Organization which he/she represents (if applicable).



VI.- ACCEPTANCE OF WORK

The Technical Council will inform participants via e-mail, no later than Friday, **July 31, 2020** if they have been chosen as speakers.

VII.- CONGRESS MEMORIES

The work which have been selected (and presented at the congress) will be published in the memoirs of the event. The author of the work gives the FECOVAL the right to publish it, but not the copyrights.

VIII.- PRESENTATION OF THE WORKS

- Works accepted to the Congress must be prepared in a power point presentation or similar format and in spanish or english.
- The speaker will have a maximum of 50 minutes to orally present his/her work, therefore we ask participants to limit themselves to presenting only the essential information of their research. However, the written submission may be broader (see "format of the works").
- For the oral presentation to take place, the President and the Secretary of the Discussion Panel must be present.
- The presentations will be evaluated by the attendees, who may ask the author questions, make clarifications or comments that they consider relevant within a time frame established for this purpose.
- The clarity of the Speakers presentation, as well as the opinions and comments made by the attendees will dictate the criteria, by which the Discussion Panel, through the President and Secretary issue a verdict at the end of the presentation and make recommendations and/or conclusions on the topic.
- The conclusion of the Discussion Panel for each presentation, will be read for approval by the attendees in the room. The president and secretary, must deliver the verdict to members of the committee or the Technical Council on the same day of the presentation.

IX.- AWARDS

All participants who present an approved work for presentation will be exempted from paying their registration fee to the congress.

All participants who present an approved work will be given a certificate of participation as a speaker of the congress.

The participants who submit the three best work will be granted the following awards:

First place: Teach a course in the 2021 National Congress and the publishing of their paper in printed media.

Second place: Speak at the 2021 National Congress and at the First 2021 FECOVAL meeting, presenting the paper with which he/she received 2nd place.

Third place: Teaching a Course at the Third 2021 FECOVAL Assembly, presenting the paper with which he/she received the 3rd place.

The assessment of the presentations will be carried out by both the attendees and the Discussion Panel.

For the assessment of papers, the following criteria will be taken into account:

- Assessment by attendees 40%
- Assessment by the Discussion Panel and participation of the attendees to each lecture 20%
- Preliminary assessment upon submission carried out by the commission of technical and/or scientific affairs and the FECOVAL technical council. 40%
